The Rector greeted the General Consulate in the Rectorate of Campus C UNAIR, where they then took up the potentials UNAIR has to collaborate with universities in Karachi.

Meanwhile, two days prior or on December 3, UNAIR signed an MOU with Sustainable Premium Education Consultancy Services (SPECS). In the signing, Prof. Dr. Moham-

mad Nasih, S.E., MT., Ak., CMA., as the Rector represented UNAIR and Prof. Mohammed Saeed as the Executive Vice Chairman was present on behalf of SPECS. The collaboration aims to strengthen UNAIR's achievement in terms of academic reputation at the international level.

PUSPAS Distributes Aid to People in Need



The waqf corner

Universitas Airlangga (UNAIR) is one of the administrators (nazhir) of cash waqf in Indonesia. Indonesia Waqf Board (BWI) has registered the university since September 27, 2018. UNAIR then appointed Center for Social Funds Management (PUSPAS) as the task force to collect, manage, and distribute social funds from the community, one of them is waqf fund.

PUSPAS has four main programs. First, Amerta Waqf or collected cash waqf from the community (waqif) that is productively managed. Second is the A Thousand Waqf Act (GEBU). This act encourages UNAIR's academic society and the public to donate their money, gold, or securities as waqf. Third is Amerta House. The Amerta House program provides a place to stay for the chosen bidikmisi scholarship grantees and assists these students to reach their dreams in the future.

Fourth is Waqf Corner. PUSPAS, in collaboration with East Java Islamic Economic Society (MES), East Java Indonesia Waqf Board (BWI), Bank Jatim Sharia, Bank Muamalat, Bank Mandiri Sharia, BNI Sharia, and CIMB Niaga Sharia, opened a Waqf Corner in the Islamic Economy Festival (Fesyar) 2019.

PUSPAS also arranged a gathering with the freshmen's parents on August 2, 5, 6, 9, and 12 this year. The parents and UNAIR officials who attended the event were then willing to donate after they listened to a presentation on PUSPAS. (*)
